The following is a general list of information to keep with your will and we recommend that you personalise this list for your own specific use:

1. Real Estate Documents

- Land Registry extracts or purchase contracts
- Mortgage documents
- Rental agreements

2. Bank and Financial Information

- Bank account numbers
- Bank contact details
- Internet banking access codes
- Pension details
- Life insurance policies
- Other financial policies and accounts
- Credit card details
- Loan and other debt documents

3. Identification Documents

- If assets are registered under passport numbers, include photocopies of relevant passports
- Passports for other countries

4. Power of Attorney Documents

- Lasting powers of attorney
- Terminally III Patients' Law documents

5. Digital Assets

- Social media account details
- Digital wallets and cryptocurrency information
- Cloud storage access
- Insurance broker contact details

6. Access Information

- Computer passwords
- Safe codes
- Safety deposit box locations and keys



7. Business Documents

- Partnership agreements
- Employment contracts

8. Professional Contacts

- Accountant contact details
- Solicitor contact details
- Investment advisor contact details

9. Personal Items

- Letters to family members
- Non-binding wishes about the distribution of your possessions

10. Final Arrangements
